



NO DRONE ZONE

Did you know that an **Unmanned Aircraft System**, commonly referred to as a drone, is considered an aircraft by government agencies? While you may want to fly your **drone** anywhere, certain restrictions apply. Drones must be operated safely and responsibly.

Here are four regulations to know before flying a drone:

- All drones must be registered with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).
- Contact the airport and FAA control tower (954)641-6000 before flying within five miles of any airport.
- Drones are prohibited from being flown within one mile of any Miami-Dade County airport.
- Unauthorized use of a drone in Miami-Dade County shall result in a civil penalty of \$500.
